



The Arts for Health and Wellbeing Programme at Cardiff and Vale University Health Board supports a variety of creative projects across a range of artistic mediums for staff, patients, and service users. It is proactive in using art to improve health and wellbeing and aims to be inclusive and representative of its community.

The Health Board is working with partners to establish an innovative project at its Llandough site - **Our Health Meadow.** It is believed to be the first of its kind at a hospital site in the UK, its goal is to establish an ecological community health park which benefits wildlife, plants and people through positive human environment interaction; it has used an eclectic and ambitious art strategy to acknowledge and enhance the experiences of all who enter the site; a key element of this is a sculpture trail which will act as a walkway through open air galleries of outdoor sculptures.
