RULES FOR ENTRY

General

- There is no nomination fee.
- Forms received after the closing date will not be eligible for consideration.
- The major proportion of the partnership must have taken place between 01.01.24 31.01.25.
- Information submitted (excluding financial information) may be used by A&B Cymru for publicity purposes unless you specifically request otherwise.
- In order to properly assess nominations, A&B Cymru will collect and process information about all individuals and organisations involved. Please visit <u>www.aandb.cymru</u> for the full Privacy Policy.
- The judges' decisions will be final and A&B Cymru reserves the right to withhold any award.
- All details are correct at the time of going to press. A&B Cymru reserves the right to vary these at its discretion.

A visual record of the partnership (i.e. photographs / film) must accompany all nominations. Completed nominations must be submitted no later than Friday 7 March 2025.

The 30th A&B Cymru Awards will take place at ICC Wales on Thursday 19 June 2025.

Business Categories

- The A&B Cymru Awards are open to all businesses supporting arts organisations and / or artists in Wales and all businesses supporting Welsh arts events internationally.
- The partnership can be financial, in-kind, or both, providing the total value is at least £500.
- The nomination can be completed by the business or arts partner, but must be read and agreed by both as an accurate record. Please tick the relevant box at the end of the form to confirm this.
- The same project may be nominated in more than one category by ticking the appropriate boxes.
- The business or arts partner may submit more than one nomination under any category.
- When an arts organisation / artist has more than one partner, each may be eligible, but a separate form must be submitted for every business nominated.

Adviser of the Year

- This category is only open to individuals from businesses registered on A&B Cymru's Board Bank, Diversity in Governance, Mentor Bank, Skills Bank or Young Professionals on Boards.
- The nomination form should be completed jointly by the arts organisation and adviser. Please tick the relevant box at the end of the form to confirm that both partners have approved the information submitted.
- When an arts organisation has worked with more than one adviser, each may be eligible, but a separate form must be submitted for every one nominated.

Robert Maskrey Award for Arts Philanthropy

- Unlike other categories, arts organisations may submit nominations for this Award without the prior knowledge of the individual(s) concerned. Should the nomination be successful, A&B Cymru will contact the partner arts organisation to discuss the Award further.
- Only one individual will be recognised in this category. No shortlist will be announced.
- Should more than one arts partner wish to nominate the same individual, a separate form must be submitted by each.
